

# NEWTOWN PIPPIN

A classic American Heirloom Apple originally from Newtown, Long Island in New York. Sometimes called Albermarle Pippin. The English became enamored with these apples after Benjamin Franklin introduced them while living in London in 1759. Newtown Pippin is the first in our Pioneer Series, showcasing unique apple varieties. It has a distinct fruity, some say pineapple aroma. As with all of our ciders this has minimal sweetness bringing out the distinct characters of this fine apple.

**Founding Father Fracas:** While Benjamin Franklin is credited with introducing this apple to England Thomas Jefferson was also fond of the Albermarle Pippin. There are some in Virginia that claim the Esopus Spitzenburg was Jefferson's favorite apple. We won't take sides but we like the exotic fruitiness of the Pippin.

**Ingredients:** Apple juice & yeast.
